What is the Future City Competition?

The National Engineers Week Future City Competition is a hands-on, real-world learning experience for middle-school students to learn how engineers shape the world we live in today as well as tomorrow. Now in it's 9th year in the Capital District and its 18th year nationally, Future City is recognized by the education and engineering communities as one of the nation's leading programs for enabling students to make the connection between math and science to engineering through its real-world applications.

Through the fall program, middle-school students work in teams to apply their innovative imaginations and early engineering skills in math, science and technology to design a realistic city of the future. With the guidance of their teacher and engineering mentor they will:

1. DESIGN their city using SimCity4 Deluxe software
2. Research and WRITE an essay on this year's topic
3. BUILD a 3-D model of their city
4. PRESENT their city on competition day, January 16, 2010.

Each year there is a different engineering essay topic that challenges the students. This year's topic is:

"Providing an affordable green living space for people who have lost their home due to a disaster or financial emergency".

Keep It Green!

The living space should use sustainable materials, have a low-carbon emissions footprint and achieve the "Green Ideals" of energy-efficient building.

Student teams represent schools across the area and compete locally for regional prizes, including a trip to Washington, DC to compete in the National Competition. Over 250 students from 25+ schools participated in last year's program. We plan to reach even more students this year.
